*Ready Children Impact Area*

#### **Alamo Quality Pathway**

In partnership with Education Support Center (ESC-20) and Workforce Solutions Alamo, we are helping early child care centers increase the quality of early childhood education.

#### **Help Me Grow 1-866-GROW210**

A free helpline for parents who have questions about their child's development and a desire to be connected to resources.

#### **Healthy Outcomes through Prevention and Early Support (HOPES)**

Supports a variety of parenting programs and support services for families with children 0-5 years of age.

#### **Maternal, Infant, Early Childhood Home Visits (MIECHV)**

Home visiting programs that improve maternal-child health outcomes and reduce child abuse.

#### **United Way Eastside Family Resource Center**

In partnership with DePelchin's Children Center, a community hub that serves families in the Eastside of San Antonio.

#### **Multiply Success**

Provides academic support for children of color in grades 4th - 9th, with an emphasis on eighth grade math proficiency.

#### **Tomorrow's Promise**

Strives to reengage opportunity youth ages 12-24 in their education or employment.

#### **Dual Generation Initiative**

Helps remove generational barriers by providing programs and resources benefiting the entire family.

Provides programs to help reduce the stress of parenting for service-connected families.

#### **Strong Families Strong Forces**

8-week class that supports military families with children through military-related transitions.

#### **United Way Child Care Scholarships**

Supports parents pursuing a first-time degree or training program by providing scholarships for quality child care.
