Our Successful Students Impact Area aims to ensures students stay engaged in school and their community. In Bexar County, 1 in 3 third-grade students do not read at grade level and 1 in 3 eighth-grade students are behind in math*. United Way works to address the challenges that students face to reach academic milestones and transition into adulthood.

Together, the Successful Students Impact Area is working to:

- Increase reading proficiency by providing academic resources and support.
- Increase math proficiency by providing STEM and STEAM-specific learning opportunities in school and out of school.
- **Reduce chronic absenteeism** by providing support services for students and their caregivers.
- Decrease the number of opportunity youth (ages 16-24) by connecting youth to education or workforce training.
