Healthy Outcomes through Prevention and Early Support (HOPES) aims to strengthen all families in Bexar County with children ages 0-5 years old to prevent child abuse and neglect through two methods: direct services and support from a community coalition.

Direct services include home visiting services, programs that build protective factors, parent support groups, maternal depression screening, early literacy promotion, case management and parent education.

HOPES also includes local collaborations with health care, faith-based organizations, child welfare, early childhood education and other family services in the community.

HOW WE MEASURE SUCCESS

- Children remain safe during and after program services
- Increasing protective factors, such as family resiliency and social support, to reduce the likelihood of abuse
