SUPPORTING MILITARY FAMILIES

Military Dual Generation

A dual-generation approach that supports both parents and children ages 0-10 years old. Parents can access education and workforce training while children receive support for healthy development, child care and school readiness.

KLRN Military Family Play & Learn

8-module program that provides fun, hands-on early learning activities for young children ages 0-10, while connecting families to helpful community resources.

Strong Families Strong Forces (SFSF)

8-week class that supports military families with children through military-related transitions.

- Helps families navigating deployments, PCS, ETS, retirement, etc.
- Strengthens the family's communication, connection and co-parenting skills
- Supports military-families with children 0-17

MEETING MILITARY NEEDS

United Way 211 Helpline

When an active duty, veteran or military family member calls 211, they will be connected with a MISSION UNITED Navigator for military-specific resources.

- Military Navigators are experienced with military-related community resources
- Resources and benefit information based on branch of service
- Assistance includes behavioral health, education, employment, financial, rent, utility assistance and more
