- **Support transition to economic stability** through essential needs and case management.
- **Increase access to healthy food** through food pantries and services.
- **Increase housing stability** by connecting people to housing support during an unexpected life event.
- **Provide emergency shelter** and supportive services for individuals and families in crisis.
